

CCW Catch Up Funding

2015-16:

The Literacy and Numeracy Catch-Up Premium provides schools with an additional £500 for each Year 7 pupil who did not achieve at least Level 4 in reading and/or maths at the end of Key Stage 2.

What was the allocation for Year 7 literacy and numeracy catch up premium for 2015-16.

HOW WAS THE YEAR 7 CATCH UP PREMIUM SPENT LAST YEAR?

- In August prior to year 7 entry to the school a two-week summer intervention with a strong emphasis on numeracy and literacy was offered to all L4 and below students.
- Students that are below level 4 were taught in smaller groups with further TA intervention.

The communication centre provides bespoke intervention to improve spelling, punctuation and grammar. The centre also supports with specialist programmes which focus on reading recovery and dyslexia.

- Maths intervention classes were provided to all students below L4 to focus on basic numeracy and developing knowledge and use of appropriate key techniques.

WHAT WAS THE IMPACT?

- In Maths 65% of students who were below level 4 on entry have made progress with 50% reaching above level 4.
- In English 87% of students who were below level 4 on entry have made progress with 87% reaching above level 4.
