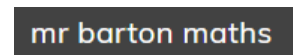

Step 1: HUG the exam question

Highlight the command word

Underline the keywords

Glance over the whole question

Step 2: structure your answer

Point

Opinion

Evidence

Reason

Explanation

Evidence/explanation

Link

Other opinions

Step 3: use appropriate themes:

- Social, economic and environmental
- Primary, secondary, immediate and long-term
- Local, national, global

Know the command word:

Assess - make an informed judged, how effective was it and why. Consider all evidence and weigh them up to conclude their effectiveness or validity.

Describe - set out the characteristics. Facts only. Use data from the figure if necessary.

Discuss - present key points about different ideas or strengths and weaknesses of an idea.

Evaluate - judge from available evidence and evaluate if it was successful or not and why.

Explain - set out the cause, purpose or reason. Use 'this is because.'
